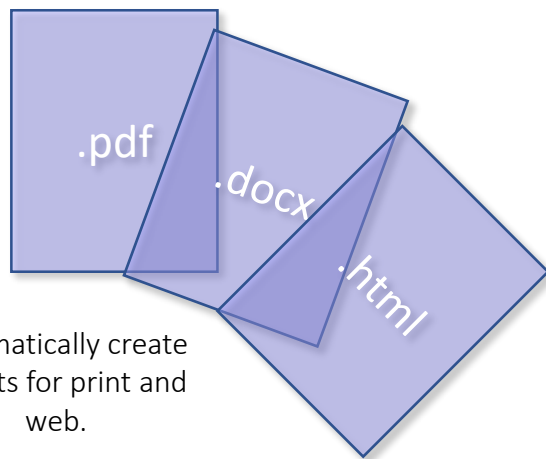

Guide to good academic writing

A number of interesting patterns emerged from the analysis of the BNC. The top four collocates (identified using the MI score, 3a-MI(3), L5-R5, C10-NC10) of the verb *fuck* include two types of grammatical words: i) adverbial particles (*off* and *up*) and ii) pronouns (*you* and *all*). The concordance lines revealed contexts in which these are used. As can be seen in example (1), the adverbial particles typically appear in phrasal verbs such as *fuck off*.
